Project Objectives	Under Directive 2008/98 / EC, Member States are required to adopt a standard methodology for recording food waste levels, with a view to the successful monitoring and evaluation of national food waste preventior programs. The measures taken by the Member States are evaluated and the results, based on the data collected, are communicated to the Commission, accompanied by a quality control report. Data collection or preparation for reuse and recycling of municipal waste requires an effective quality control system and traceability of material waste streams. In the quality control report, Member States should include data on quantities of food waste and food waste prevention data. Production for each calendar year, based on the format, considers the methodologies laid down in Commission Delegated Decision (EU) 2019/1597 which provides a standard methodology for measuring food waste levels. The purpose of this project is the quantification of the amounts of food waste generated at each stage of the food supply chain in accordance with the Commission Delegated Decision (EU) 2019/1597. The quantification will be executed for the five different stages of the food waste production, namely primary production; processing and manufacturing; retain and other distribution of food; restaurants and food services; and households. The measurement shall cover food waste that is classified under the waste codes referred to in Annex II of the Commission Delegated Decision (EU) 2019/1597 or under any other waste code for waste that includes food waste. The amount of food waste generated will be identified for a full calendar year. The amount of food waste for a given stage of the food supply chain using the methodology set out in Annex III of the Commission Delegated Decision (EU) 2019/1597
